### **1. Harvesting is our responsibility!**

Read: **Mark 4:26-29**

- Who did the sowing? The man.
- Who did the growing? God gives the increase
- Who reaped the harvest? The man.

Read: **Matthew 9:38 ; John 4:35**

### **2. Every Harvest starts with a Seed of Faith**

Read: **Genesis 8:22 (AMPC)**  
**Ecclesiastes 11:4 (AMPC & NLT)**

**You have faith in a seed, that`s why you plant it!**

### WHAT A GOOD SOWER KNOWS:

- Sowing is a Lifestyle (Mark 4:3)
- Sow your best seed into good ground: Local Church
- God gives seed to sowers (2 Cor 9:10)
- We sow for a harvest, not just from a harvest (Luke 6:38)
- Your seed takes care of your need, and your overflow takes care of the needs of others!
- Every Seed has Life within itself and reproduces according to its own kind! (Gen 1:11)
- What I sow is what I reap (Gal 6:7)
- (You must plant what you expect to harvest.)
- The measure I sow is the measure I reap (2 Cor 9:6)
- Sow for increase (Mark 4:8)
- You always reap MORE than what you sow (1 Cor 3:6-7)
- FIRSTFRUITS belong to God (Prov 3:9-10)
- There is time between sowing and reaping; but the harvest can come at any time! (Eccl 11:6)
- We Reap the Full Harvest of the Good Only if We PERSEVERE (Gal 6:9-10)  
Weeds/tares comes to the harvest on it's own.
- Your expenses are highest at harvest time (Matt 20:1)
- In the middle of a bad harvest you can still change your seed!

### 3. Our Harvest follows our Words

- o We release faith with our words.
- o The words we speak today determine tomorrow's harvest.
- o When we're speaking, we are sowing.
- o We reap our harvest the same way we acquire anything else—by faith.
- o You must sow the seed of the Word in faith, expecting it to grow.
- o We call those things which be not as though they were.
- o Our words of faith cut down the crops and bring in the harvest.
- o Declare this: "I expect my harvest every time I sow my seed."
