SERMON TITLE: Say To the Righteous – Ps At Boshoff

WELCOME: Welcome all New Visitors. Do an Icebreaker.

WORSHIP: SING: 1 Praise Song & 2 Worship Songs. During Prayer Time focus on God’s GREATNESS AND POWER!

WORD

Isaiah 3:10
 “Say to the righteous that it shall be well with them, for they shall eat the fruit of their doings.”

QUESTION 1: In this prophesy Isaiah talks about “the righteous.” When the Bible refers to “the righteous” who is it referring to?

According to you, who are “the righteous”?

Answer: Everyone who have accepted Jesus Christ as their Lord and Saviour

Ask a few cell members to read the following scriptures: **Romans 5:19; 2 Corinthians 5:21**

QUESTION 2: According to these scriptures, what part do we play in becoming righteous?

Answer: We play no part at all. Your religious works, devotions, and sacrifices can’t make you righteous. That man who is righteous in the sight of God is one who is made righteous by God.

Let’s look again at Isaiah 3:10 - “Say to the righteous that it shall be well with them...”

IT SHALL BE WELL WITH THE RIGHTEOUS ALWAYS, AND AT ALL TIMES, AND IN ALL CIRCUMSTANCES.

It shall be well with the righteous:

- When all hell breaks loose...
- In the fiery trial... (see James 1:12)
- In the valley...
- In the raging storm... (see John 16:33)
- When temptation comes... (see 1 Corinthians 10:13)

Ask a few cell members to read the following scriptures: **James 5:11; Isaiah 41:10; Jeremiah 29:11-14**

On Sunday Pastor At shared 4 principles from **2 Kings 4:16-23** on what to do when your dream is under attack.

Ask a cell member to read **2 Kings 4:16-23**

QUESTION 3: From your point of view what did this lady do that turned the most dramatic experience in her life into victory?

QUESTION 4: If you could take one lesson from this story, what would it be?

1. THE FIRST LESSON WE CAN LEARN FROM THIS LADY IS TO: RUN TO GOD WHEN YOU ARE UNDER ATTACK YOU BETTER RUN TO GOD AND NOT FROM HIM

Ask a few cell members to read the following scriptures: **Isaiah 40:28-31; Isaiah 59:1; Psalm 34:4; Ephesians 3:20; Philippians 4:6-7 2.**

2. THE SECOND LESSON WE CAN LEARN FROM THIS LADY IS TO: MAKE A DEMAND ON THE ANOINTING

SHE TOOK HER CHILD AND LAID HIM ON THE PROPHET'S BED. SHE THEN WENT TO THE PROPHET AND WOULD NOT LEAVE HIM UNTIL HER SON WAS RAISED.

Ask a cell member to read the following scripture: **Hebrews 4:16**

QUESTION 5: Why is it that so many children of God do not have the boldness to go to their Father and ask boldly for His help?

3. THE THIRD LESSON WE CAN LEARN FROM THIS LADY IS TO: SAY IT AGAIN, AND AGAIN UNTIL!

THIS SHUNNAMITE WOMAN DECLARED IT TO HER HUSBAND "IT IS WELL." SHE DECLARED IT TO THE PROPHET: "IT IS WELL!"

Ask a few cell members to read the following scriptures: **Proverbs 18:21; Hebrews 10:23; 2 Corinthians 4:13**

YOU BETTER SAY TO YOURSELF... "IT SHALL BE WELL WITH ME!" YOU BETTER SAY TO YOUR SPOUSE... "IT WILL BE WELL WITH US!"

4. THE FOURTH LESSON WE CAN LEARN FROM THIS LADY IS TO: KEEP YOUR EYES ON JESUS... AND BE AT PEACE

SHE KEPT HER EYES ON THE MAN OF GOD AND NEVER BECAME UNSETTLED

Ask a few cell members to read the following scriptures: **Isaiah 26:3; John 14:27**
