WORD

1. God loves us more than we will ever know

Read Romans 5:8-10 (NKJV)

- **God is a man-chaser, you didn't find Him, He found you!**
- **He is the Good Shepherd!**
- He chose you before the foundation of the world
(Not based on your performance)
- He chose you in His good pleasure
(You are an absolute pleasure to God)
- He chose you once and for all time
(You cannot be un-chosen)

Read Hebrews 13:5 (AMPC)

- **God will never leave you or forsake you.**
(Poem insert – Footprints in the sand by Mary Stevenson)

2. There is more to God than we will ever know

Read 1 Corinthians 2:9-11 (NIV)

- **God's got stuff you haven't imagined / conceived.**
- If you had to see all the things God is still going to do for you, you would not believe it.
- God will open up the windows of heaven in your spirit to see opportunity. (**Malachi 3:10**)
Jesus said the Kingdom of Heaven is inside of us.

Read Ephesians 3:20 (NKJV)

- Pray prayers that only God can answer.
- Keep your **spirit of increase!**
- Expect and anticipate good and great things coming your way in Jesus Name!
- God wants to show you how awesome He is.
- You are destined to rule and reign with Christ. (**Romans 5:17**)

3. God has more for us

Read Jeremiah 29:11 (NKJV)

- **God loves you and He has a wonderful plan for your life!**
- Receive more of His love by giving more of yourself to Him.
Enjoy His love for you and delight in Him.

Read John 10:10 (TPT)

- **God is not just enough, He is more than enough!**
- God speaks to you about your future! (*You cannot change the past / failure is not fatal or final*)
- When you follow God it is a journey of increase, not decrease. (**Isaiah 48:17**)
- Get a Vision for increase / overflow and stay faithful in the journey.
Renew your mind and get busy possessing your Promised Land.
- God's provision is not a cake with limited slices.
- There is no scarcity, lack or competition for resources in God's Kingdom.
- God is good and gives the same wages to all.

OWN NOTES:

Read Philippians 4:19 (NKJV)

- God gives by the standard of His riches, not by the standard of our lack. He gives extravagantly, without measuring your vessel – He gives overflow (**Luke 6:38**) God gives with the style of a King! He always gives. Giving doesn't make Him poorer. The indescribable and extravagant gift of His Son Jesus is God's style of generosity! His scale is worthy of His greatness. His generosity always exceeds ours.
- God is Jehovah Jireh: The Lord who provides.
- He knows my need because He sees my need.
- He will see to it that your every need is met.
- God is: I AM (*whatever you need me to be*)

4. There is more we are called to do for God

➤ **God wants you to prosper:**

- *Because He loves you as His child.*
- *He wants to free you from the care of things.*
- *He wants to empower you to be generous.*
- *He wants to enable us to win the lost and build the Church.*

➤ **PROSPERITY WITH PURPOSE**

- *More than enough of God's supply to follow His instructions.*

We learn that God gives wealth so that He may establish His covenant of salvations (**Deuteronomy 8:18**).

Pro-Vision follows Vision: God blesses His own plans.

Our overflow meets the needs of others, we are blessed to be a blessing.

Read Proverbs 11:24-25 (TPT)

We are generous and grateful to God, because He is ALWAYS generous in His love for us.

A generous heart flows from a grateful heart, and shows how much we want to express our love for Jesus.
