Read Proverbs 20:6 (NKJV)

QUESTION: According to the verse above, what is God looking for?

1. Take responsibility for God's family

- In the House there should be many Father's for those who never had a father
- **Children from fatherless homes are more likely to be poor, become involved in drug and alcohol abuse, drop out of school, and suffer from mental health and emotional problems.**
- Promiscuity and teen pregnancy: Delinquency and youth crime, including violent crime.
- **Behavioural problems, drug and alcohol abuse, Exploitation and abuse.**
- Let us be Fathers to the fatherless!
- **God builds relationally with Fathers & Sons**

2. Leave an inheritance for your family

- **Proverbs 17:6** (NKJV)
- A **GOOD** man is generationally minded
- An evil man is not and refuses to build a legacy
- Adam abandoned his calling, position, role. He was **hiding** from God in his garden (house) He used leaves (religion) as a cover up.
- **GOD is asking: Adam where are you?**
- You may not have been able to do it all in the past or now but Jesus has done it all on your behalf!

3. What did God your Father do for you?

- **John 3:16** (NKJV)
- God Himself is a father!
- He gave His life for His Family, He gave His life for you!
- He is not just God in Heaven He is also our Father and we are now His sons if we receive Jesus!
