WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell.

WORSHIP

Prepare Praise and Worship for the Homecell gathering (1 Praise & 2 Worship songs)

WORD

Ask a cell member to read Colossians 1:9-14 & John 8:28-32

QUESTION 1: How would you define a life “fully pleasing” to God?

*Answer: 1. Being fruitful in every good work
2. Increasing in the knowledge of God
3. Being filled with wisdom and strength*

QUESTION 2: Jesus is by far our best example of living a life pleasing to His Father. What did Jesus do – according to John 8 – that supported His desire to live a life pleasing to His Father?

Answer: It is obvious that Jesus lived a life...

- *consecrated to His Father's will – “Not My will be done but Your will be done!”*
- *empowered by the Holy Spirit;*
- *filled with and led by the Holy Spirit.*

Your future should not be a mystery. God sent the Holy Spirit to lead and guide you in the truth.

Ps At Boshoff

Romans 8:14 The Passion Translation

The mature children of God are those who are moved by the impulses of the Holy Spirit.

**Many people say that God never talks to them. God talks to you all the time!
Unfortunately, most Christians are not in tune with the impulses of the Holy Spirit.**

QUESTION 3: The Holy Spirit will never lead us outside of the Word of God (the Bible). Why, would you say, is the Bible still the most relevant source of wisdom and guidance up until today?

With modern technology there's more access to the Word of God than ever. Yet, the Bible has become the most unread book in the world.

Ps At Boshoff

Ask a cell member to read John 8:31-32 again

QUESTION 4: What do you think Jesus meant when He said we need to “*abide in His Word?*”

Answer: Abiding means to bear patiently (to tolerate); to accept without objection (yield to); to remain stable in or fixed to. In short: abiding in the Word means to submit to and accept God's Word as the final authority in my life and to stay committed to His Word.

Ask a cell member to read Proverbs 3:5-8

QUESTION 5: If we say we need to yield to and submit to the Word of God, what does that mean?

Answer: Ultimately it means the Word becomes the final authority in my life. My opinions, feelings, culture, traditions etc. must bow to and give way to the principles of God's Word. I accept the Word of God without objection.

You cannot treat the Word of God like a menu and expect God to lead you into all the truth.

Ps At Boshoff

QUESTION 6: What will the consequences be if we decide not to give God's Word preeminence in our life?

Answer: If we treat the Word of God without respect it implies that God has not full ownership over our life. God said that even He is submitted to His Word. God cannot operate outside of His Word. If we're not serious about the authority of God's Word in our life, we'll never experience the life God intended for us.

Ask a cell member to read 2 Timothy 3:16 from the Amplified Bible

QUESTION 7: According to this scripture, what role should God's Word fulfill in our lives?

WORKS

PRAY FOR: we're trusting God for every backslider and prodigal to return. Stand in agreement tonight as you trust God for everyone of your cell members to return to their Heavenly Father.
