WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell.

WORSHIP

Prepare Praise and Worship for the Homecell gathering (1 Praise & 2 Worship songs)

WORD

IMPORTANT NOTE: Allow for at least 15min for prayer at the end of the homecell meeting.

Ask a cell member to read Habakkuk 2:1-4, 19

QUESTION 1: What would you say are some of the things/principles that determine the successful outcome of our lives?

- Answer:*
1. Our willingness to connect with God (to worship Him; to connect with Him; to listen to Him; to obey His Word etc.)
 2. Our consecration to God and His will (not my will be done but Your will be done)
 3. Our ability to discern His will through the guidance of the Holy Spirit
 4. Submission to godly counsel (this will requires humility)
 5. Living out God's will by faith

I want to make this clear, God has a perfect plan for your life: whom you should marry; where you should live; what your purpose is in life; which local church you should be planted in.

Ps At Boshoff

Ask a cell member to read Psalms 23:1-6

QUESTION 2: In the context of God's plan for our life, what can we learn from what David said in Psalms 23?

- Answer:* We should live confidently, anchored in the Word of God, certain that no matter where we are or what we face, God will lead us safely to the other side.

Ask a few cell members to read Habakkuk 2:18-19 (MSG); Leviticus 19:4, 31; 1 Chronicles 10:13-14a

QUESTION 3: What would you say is the primary message we get from these scriptures?

Answer: The Bible is clear that we are never to seek guidance outside of God and His word. This will result in serious calamity. Saul lost his kingdom and died because he turned away from God and sought guidance from another medium.

Ask a few cell members to read Psalm 121:1-4; Isaiah 58:11; Isaiah 30:21; Isaiah 48:17

It is God's desire to reveal the future to His children. He does not want us to live a guessing life or stumbling through life as those who are blind in the darkness. As our Father He wants to guide us into the detailed plans He has for us.

Ps At Boshoff

Psalm 32:8-9 The Passion Translation

I hear the Lord saying, "I will stay close to you, instructing and guiding you along the pathway for your life. I will advise you along the way and lead you forth with my eyes as your guide. So don't make it difficult; don't be stubborn when I take you where you've not been before. Don't make me tug you and pull you along. Just come with me!"

QUESTION 4: How does this passage relate to your life and current situation?

Ask a few cell members to read John 14:26; John 16:13; Romans 8:14-16

Ask a few cell members to share a short testimony of how they experienced the guidance of the Holy Spirit when they had to make some tough decisions in their life.

QUESTION 5: The Holy Spirit has been sent by Jesus to reveal God's plan and purpose for our life to us. What can we practically do to learn to better discern the voice of the Holy Spirit?

Answer: The key is to build a relationship with the Holy Spirit by:

- *Spending time in His presence seeking and worshipping God*
- *Spending time in prayer*
- *Spending time waiting and watching*
- *Spending time reading and meditating on the Word of God*

The more you read and meditate in the Word, the more your spirit man will become sensitive to the inner leading of the Holy Spirit.
