WELCOME

WORSHIP

Prepare Praise and Worship for the Homecell gathering. (1 Praise & 2 Worship songs)

WORD

Read Jeremiah 29:11-13 (NIV); John 10:10 (NKJV) & 1 Corinthians 2:9 (ESV)

Question: What do these scriptures have in common?

Answer: They are promises from God. Promises of a great future. Something to look forward to. A Hope!

The promise is there, now the believing and thinking takes us to the promise! - Read Proverbs 23:7 (NKJV)

Read Romans 12:2-3 (AMPC)

Question: What does “conformed to the world” mean?

Answer:

- Not just sin, its desires for worldly things
- Not to think like God (thinking small / insignificant)
- Being shaped or molded into the pattern of the world.

Right thinking starts with right believing:

- **GOD:** Loves you and has a great plan for you
- **IDENTITY:** You have all it takes because God made you in His image
- **POTENTIAL:** You have the Bible and the Holy Spirit to conquer and overcome any obstacle that comes your way

Right thinking = Change = God’s will

① **RIGHT THINKING WILL BE CHALLENGED:**

Right thinking = God’s will = God’s thinking

- Always **REMEMBER** what the Lord has done in your life! - Read Exodus 13:3 (NKJV)
- You have a **PROMISE** from God! – Read Exodus 13:5 (AMPC) & Exodus 13:17 (NKJV)
- You will be **CHALLENGED** by your past / enemies! – Read Exodus 14:5 (NKJV)

Question: What in your past challenge you?

Answer: Comfort zones, experiences, hurts, relationships, success, failures, normal, used to, racism, poverty

- If **BELIEF** is challenged, **COMPLAINING** starts! – Read Exodus 14:11-12 (ESV)
- Change is inevitable, Growth is optional
- Your life does not get better by chance, it gets better by change
- Change begins at the end of your comfort zone
- Progress is impossible without change
- God never changes but your relationship with God changes

② RIGHT THINKING LEADS TO RIGHT CHOOSING:

Right choosing = God's will = Submitting

Read 2 Corinthians 10:5 (NKJV); Philippians 4:8 (NKJV); Romans 8:5-7 (NKJV); Galatians 6:7-9 (NKJV); Deuteronomy 30:19 (NKJV) & James 1:5-8 (ESV)

Question: In which ways can you choose right?

Answer:

- Spending your time, talents, treasure & living life
- Who you marry, where you work, friends, conversations, exploits for God
- Developing spiritual growth
- Go for that check up at the doctor
- Talk to your spouse about that issue
- Talk to your children – Hug them, love them
- Discipline and protect your children
- Become that parent that you never had
- Become the best version of who God made you to be
- Do not quit, finish strong
- You will get a job, God will provide

③ RIGHT THINKING LEADS TO DESTINY:

Destiny = Fulfilling that which God called you to do

"If you change the way you look at things, the things you look at will change!" ~ Ps Pierre Spies

Read Romans 8:28 (ESV)

- You will never succeed with an inferior mindset. You must know who you are. In fact, the first giant you may need to defeat is "you... your mindset". Make a decision to become who God says you are. It doesn't matter what others think of say about you, it's about how you see yourself.
- It is not over! God is not done with you! You have to trust God in faith! Walk by faith!
